IFAC MIM 2022 in numbers:

113 leading scientists from **28** countries in the International Program Committee

78 countries were represented via the contributors

806 submissions received (including 78 special session proposals)

837 reviewers participated in the peer review process

~2000 reviews received approximately (with a minimum of 2 reviews per paper)

544 papers accepted after the peer review process

1908 authors from **68** countries in the program (**125** sessions)

7 exceptional keynote speakers:

25 prizes for the best papers presented
